

Ossian Town Board Minutes

- Call to Order:** The Regular Board Meeting of the Ossian Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Knapp at 7:30 pm.
- Pledge to Flag** The pledge to the flag was led by Councilman Pero.
- Approval of Minutes:** The minutes for the February 8, 2022 Regular Board Meeting were presented. Councilman Mark corrected the minutes by changing the date of the Clerk report from September 2020 to January 2022. Councilman Patane moved to accept the February 8, 2022 minutes as corrected. Councilman Jaeger seconded the motion. Carried.
- Communications:** Supervisor Knapp stated that the youth program in Ossian will be held last week of July. Tom Depuy is our Senior of the Year. He also stated that there is another Harassment training March 24, at 10 am for those still in need of this. Also on March 31, at 6PM there will be a meeting updating the Zoning Committee on the changes going on with solar and if we need to update our Solar Law.
- Financial Report:** The Financial Report for February 2022 was distributed by the Supervisor. Total receipts were \$482,667.22 and total disbursements were \$35,614.83. Councilman Pero moved to accept the Financial Report as presented. Councilman Mark seconded the motion. Carried.
- Claims:** Highway claims #27 through #47 totaling \$41,632.16 and General Fund claims #28 through #38 totaling \$5,675.48 were presented for payment. Councilman Pero moved to accept all claims as presented. Councilman Patane seconded the motion. Carried.
- Reports:** Town Clerk VanHeusen reported a total business for February 2022 of \$150.00. The Towns share is \$150.00 which is presented to the Supervisor.
Code Enforcement Officer Bourgoine informed the Board that he issued 2 building permits.
Assessor Smalt reported that she has been working on exemptions. She also is working on finishing up the Reval. Notices will be going out in the next couple of weeks with the new assessments. March 18 will be the start of informal meetings with the property owners.

Highway Superintendent Young reported that they have been doing some plowing and hauling stone for the County. Judge Wilson did total business in February of \$1006.50. Chairman of ZBA Tom DePuy stated that his committee will be doing 3 variances. Tom also stated that they are planning a joint meeting with the Planning Board to go over the Zoning laws and do some house keeping to correct some issues.

Other Business: Tom depuy reported that Jesse Wiedman will be moving and will be resigning from The Board of Assessment Review . John VanHeusen will replace him once his resignation is received and the Town Board appoints John VanHeusen to take his place.

Adjournment: Councilman Pero moved to adjourn. Council Jaeger seconded the motion. Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
