- Call to Order:** The Regular Meeting of the Ossian Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Dwight Knapp at 7:30 PM.
- Pledge:** The pledge to the flag was led by Keith Young.
- Approval of Minutes:** The minutes from the Regular Meeting of May 14, 2024 Ossian Town Board Minutes were presented. Councilman Pero moved to accept the minutes as presented. Councilman Barron seconded the motion. Carried.
- Recognitions:** Tonight 5 Teens and Senior of the Year were presented. Heather Pero our Teen Advisor introduced the 5 teens, Tyler VanAuken, Grace Rechichi, Corey Beman, Ethan Canfield, and Kaitlyn Lee. A short bio was read about each teen. - Financial Report:** Supervisor Knapp presented the financial report for the month of May 2024. Total disbursements were \$51,461.09 total receipts were \$62,891.45. Councilman Pero moved to accept the financial Report. Councilman Barron seconded the motion. Carried
- Claims:** Highway Fund claims #78 through #94 totaling \$193,057.80 and General Fund claims #55 through #72 totaling \$4,310.64 were presented for audit. Councilman Barron moved to accept all claims presented for payment. Councilman Pero seconded the motion. Carried.
- Reports:** Judge Wilson \$900.00 in fines. The Town Clerk \$ 261.00 in Fees collected for May 2024. CEO Quinn Golden handed a written report to all board members. Highway Superintendent Young reported they were doing oil and stone for the county. Also new loader and pickup are here. Attended Highway School where the main topic was CHIPS funding. Assessor Smalt submitted a written stating that she was busy with grievances. She also

reported that the town has a rating of 98% for assessments. The town will use Office 365 for our secure emails at a cost of 912.00 per year.
