## RESOLUTION TO INTRODUCE PROPOSED LOCAL LAW #1 OF 2024 AND TO SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Ossian, New York desires to consider adopting legislation to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Ossian pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 3-c, and to allow the Town of Ossian to adopt a town budget for fiscal Year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the tax levy limit, also known as Town of Ossian Local Law #1 of 2024.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Board of the Town of Ossian, New York that proposed Local Law #1 of 2024 entitled "A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit" established in General Municipal Law Section 3-c, which proposed Local Law is now in its final form as appears by a copy thereof hereto attached, by the same hereby is introduced for adoption; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy be laid upon the desks of the members of this Town Board on this date and remain there and a copy thereof be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk until September 10, 2024 and that a public hearing be held before this Town Board on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2024 at 7:30 pm at the Ossian Town Hall, 4706 Ossian Hill Road, Dansville, New York on the advisability of enacting said proposed Local Law; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of said proposed Local Law be mailed to each member of the Town Board not in attendance at this meeting in a postpaid, properly addressed and securely closed envelope, in a post box within the Town of Ossian, New York, not less than ten (10) calendar days, exclusive of Sunday, prior to the date of said public hearing: and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town Clerk shall cause notice of said public hearing to be published once in the Livingston County News at least five (5) days prior to the date of said public hearing, which notice shall contain the time and place of said hearing, the title and purpose thereof, as well as a statement that a copy of said proposed Local Law is on file in the Town Clerk's Office.
